Summary:

Update 4/8/10 at 8:15pm.

This evening at about 7:15pm. 44year old Juneau resident Christopher Bruce BARRIOS was arrested for Attempted Murder in the Second Degree which is an Unclassified felony in connection with this case. He was lodged at Lemon Creek Correctional Center without bail.

Update 3/31/10 at 2:00p.m.

Detectives were able to interview several witnesses and obtained two (2) search warrants; one for a person and the other for a residence in the Thane Campground area. Police recovered two (2) handguns and clothing with blood on them. Witnesses said about six (6) people were sitting around a campfire drinking alcohol and shooting guns. It is still unclear how the 50 year old Washington man ended up with a gunshot wound.

The investigation into this case is on-going

On 03-30-10 at about 10:06 p.m., JPD officers responded to Bartlett Regional Hospital as a 50 year old Washington man had arrived for treatment with a gunshot wound.

The man was being tended to by emergency room staff and was unavailable for questioning. Investigation revealed the man was brought from the area of The Thane Campground to BRH via private vehicle. Circumstances surrounding the incident were suspicious and an investigation is ongoing. The man was flown to Harborview Medical Center for treatment of his injury and is expected to survive.
