Summary:

On 04/14/2010, the Juneau Police Department received a report of a female attempting to pass 8 counterfeit \$100.00 bills at Wal-Mart. Officers responded and contacted 63-year-old Washington resident Patricia L. COMER, at Wal-Mart. COMER was detained and brought to the Juneau Police Department for questioning.

Interviews with COMER and a search of her belongings revealed she was in possession of prescription medication not prescribed to her. She additionally told Officers she was in town selling Oxycodone pills.

COMER was placed under arrest for Misconduct Involving a Controlled Substance in the 2nd Degree and Misconduct Involving a Controlled Substance in the 4th Degree. COMER was transported to and lodged at the Lemon Creek Correctional Center and held on no bail.

The investigation into the counterfeit money continues.

Any charges reported in this press release are merely accusations and the defendants are presumed innocent unless and until proven guilty.
