Douglas Soapbox Derby

The Douglas 4th of July Soapbox Challenge will take place on both the 3rd and 4th of July. The location of the race is on St. Ann's Avenue from Summers Street down to 3rd Street. Time trial races will take place on July 3rd starting at 5:30 PM. The time trials will continue until finished at approximately 9:00 pm. The race finals will start on the 4th of July immediately after the Douglas Parade. The finals will continue until finished at approximately 5:30 pm.

Starting July 3rd at 2:00 pm, St Ann's Avenue from Summers Street to 3rd Street will be closed to vehicular traffic. The road will remain closed to traffic until approximately 6:00 pm on July 4th. During this time the road will be barricaded and both edges of St. Ann's will be lined with tires.

Any vehicle parked on St. Ann's Avenue from Summers Street to 3rd Street during this closure will be cited and impounded at the owner's expense. Impounded vehicles will not be available for pickup until Tuesday, July 6th. The Douglas boat harbor parking lot will be available for parking.

Juneau 4TH of July Parade

The Juneau 4th of July parade will begin at 12:00 noon at the Department of Labor building on West 8th Street. The parade route is as follows:

The parade will begin at Egan Drive and West 8th Street. It will travel inbound on Egan Drive via the outbound lanes to Main Street. It will turn left and travel up Main Street. The parade will turn right onto Front Street and continue on Front Street traveling against the normal flow of traffic. It will turn right onto Franklin Street and travel against the normal flow of traffic to the traffic circle. The parade will then head outbound on Egan Drive via the inbound lanes to West 8th.

The Juneau Police Department will be closing all of the above-referenced streets to vehicular traffic starting at approximately 11:30 AM. All listed streets will be posted "No Parking".

Any vehicles parked on the parade route will be impounded at the owner's expense, and vehicles will be unavailable for pick up until Tuesday, July 6th. The Juneau Police Department will begin impounding vehicles at 9:30 A.M. on the morning of July 4th.

Due to the large volume of July 4th foot traffic, the streets surrounding the parade route become very congested. For the safety of those participating and watching the parade, all traffic will be held until the parade is complete and has passed the 10th Street and Egan Drive intersection. All streets and parking lots within the parade route boundary will also be closed to vehicular traffic during this time.

Douglas 4TH of July Parade

The Douglas 4th of July parade will begin at 3:00 PM. The parade route is from 3rd Street at I Street to St. Ann's Avenue at A Street. 3rd Street will be posted "No Parking" from 11:00 A.M. until 5:00 P.M.

During this period of time, traffic will be routed into Douglas on 4th Street and out of Douglas on 2nd Street. To accommodate this, 2nd Street will be posted as One Way northbound and 4th Street will be posted as One Way southbound. 2nd, 3rd, and 4th Streets will be posted as "No Parking".

Any vehicle parked on the above-listed streets will be cited and impounded at the owner's expense. Impounded vehicles will not be available for pickup until Tuesday, July 6th. The Douglas boat harbor parking lot will be available for parking.
