Subject: Head Injury

Summary:

On July 1, 2010, at approximately 6:30 AM, officers from the Juneau Police Department responded to a reported fight between two females and one male outside a residence in the 4400 block of Kanata Deyi.

Officers learned that a 16 year old intoxicated male had been fighting with an 18 year old female who lives at the residence and with her 15 year old boyfriend. Officers arrested the 16 year old male for Assault 4th degree DV (reference 18 year old female), Assault 4th degree (reference 15 year old male) and Resisting Arrest, all Class A Misdemeanors.

Officers also contacted Katherine Milton at the residence, who is the mother of the 16 year old male. She was intoxicated and interfered with officers as they arrested her son. She was placed under arrest for Interfering with the Duties of a Police Officer, a Class A Misdemeanor. She was lodged at Lemon Creek Correctional Center and bail was set at \$1,000 cash.

As officers gained control of the situation they requested medical assistance from Capital City Fire Rescue for a 40 year old male who was lying on the living room floor and not responsive. CCFR responded and transported him to Bartlett Regional Hospital where it was determined he had a serious head injury. He was listed in critical condition and airlifted to Harborview Medical Center for treatment.

This case is actively under investigation by detectives regarding the head injury to the 40 year old male.

Any charges reported in this press release are merely accusations and the defendants are presumed innocent unless and until proven guilty.
