**Summary:** 

On 07-13-10 at about 9:30 p.m., a JPD officer on patrol on Alaway Ave noticed a suspicious male peering into parked vehicles in the area. Believing the subject may be attempting to rifle the vehicle, the officer made contact with the subject. The subject fled on foot toward a wooded area but was located and detained by officers.

Investigation revealed the subject was carrying a concealed handgun on his person. The handgun was reported stolen by a Juneau citizen on 04-30-10 in a prior theft.

The subject, 29 year old Juneau resident Charles Brouillette, was ultimately lodged at the Lemon Creek Correctional Center and charged with Resisting/Interfering with an Officer (Class A Misdemeanor), Misconduct Weapons 3<sup>rd</sup> Degree (Class C Felony), Misconduct Involving Weapons 5<sup>th</sup> Degree (Class B Misdemeanor) and Theft II (Class C Felony). He was held without bail.

Any charges reported in this press release are merely accusations and the defendants are presumed innocent unless and until proven guilty.
