Summary:

On 08-08-2010, at about 1832 hours, the Juneau Police Department received a report of a female who had been sprayed with mace in the 2200 block of Trout Street. The caller advised the female was having difficulty breathing and was about to pass out. Capital City Fire Rescue arrived on scene and treated an 18 year old Oregon woman for exposure to pepper spray. The female advised responding Officers there was another individual in their room who had also been sprayed.

Investigation revealed that the 18 year old female was with a 21 year old Juneau man in a private room when an unknown subject entered the room and used pepper spray on the occupants. The 21 year old Juneau man reported items taken from his room. Both subjects were treated by CCFR and released at the scene.

Investigation continues.

Any charges reported in this press release are merely accusations and the defendants are presumed innocent unless and until proven guilty.
