Subject: Violation of Protective Orders Date: Friday, August 20, 2010

## **Summary:**

On the evening of 08/19/2010 and into the early morning hours of 08/20/2010, the Juneau Police Department received three separate reports from two people saying that Christopher ROSE, 41-year old male, who had been previously served with a Domestic Violence Protective Order and a Stalking Protective Order had allegedly violated the court orders by both verbally contacting and threatened them. The orders prohibited ROSE from contacting them directly or indirectly.

JPD officers went to the downtown area apartment where ROSE resides. ROSE was contacted at his residence but would not open the door. He first barricaded the door with furniture then threatened to jump out the sixth floor window if officers entered the residence.

Officers waited out the situation until ROSE later exited the front door where he was contacted and placed under arrest. He was charged with one count of violating a Domestic Violence Protective Order and two counts of violating a Stalking Protective Order. All three offenses are Class A Misdemeanors.

ROSE was taken to and lodged at LCCC on no bail.

Any charges reported in this press release are merely accusations and the defendants are presumed innocent unless and until proven guilty.
