Summary:

On 09/03/2010, at approximately 6:00 am, the Juneau Police Department received a report from a 28-year old woman saying that as she was parked along Montana Creek Road in the Mendenhall Valley, an adult man had first assaulted her then broke out her vehicle windows. She further stated that the man was in possession of a firearm and had walked away with several other people.

JPD Officers converged on the area of Montana Creek and contacted several people who had witnessed the incident. They also contacted the victim and 26-year old Christopher DAVIDSON.

Through witness statements and evidence gathered at the scene, it was determined that DAVIDSON had been one of three occupants in a vehicle, which had earlier been driven into the ditch along Glacier Highway in the Auke Bay area. The 28year old woman had been telephoned by the occupants of the wrecked vehicle for a ride out of the area. She picked them up and drove them to the Montana Creek area.

While in the Montana Creek area, DAVIDSON became angry at the 28-year old woman. He assaulted her by striking her several times. He then broke out the rear window and rear taillights of her vehicle. As he was outside, he allegedly brandished a firearm at her. She fled the area by driving away and called the police.

DAVIDSON was placed under arrest for Criminal Mischief in the 3rd Degree and Assault in the 3rd Degree, both Class C Felonies. He was lodged at Lemon Creek Correctional Center on no bail.

Any charges reported in this press release are merely accusations and the defendants are presumed innocent unless and until proven guilty.
