Subject: Motor vehicle collision

Summary:

On Sept. 15, 2010, at about 8:04 PM, the Juneau Police Department received a report of a vehicle colliding with a residence on W 12th Street. Officers arrived at 705 W 12th Street and found a 1999 maroon Ford F-150 was resting up against the front of the residence.

The 3 occupants of the Ford were standing in front of the residence. Capital City Fire Rescue (CCFR) responded to evaluate the occupants of the Ford. The 16 year old driver and a 19 year old passenger were transported to Bartlett Regional Hospital by CCFR for evaluation of non life threatening injuries. A 17 year old passenger was released from the scene to her father.

Investigation revealed the Ford, which was operated by a 16 year old, was accelerating as it made a right turn off of Glacier Avenue onto W 12th Street. The 16 year old driver lost control of the vehicle. The vehicle drove up on to the sidewalk, through the front yard and then collided with the front of 705 W 12th Street. The home owner was not in the residence at the time of the collision.

The 1999 Ford F-150 was totaled. The residence sustained damage to the exterior and interior.

The 16 year old driver was cited for driving in violation of a provisional license and negligent driving.

All factual allegations contained in this release are based upon preliminary investigation and are subject to change or clarification as the investigation continues. Any charges reported in this release are merely accusations and all persons named in this release are presumed innocent unless and until proven guilty.
