Subject: Disorderly Conduct

Summary:

On 10-19-10 at about 1530 hours, a school bus driver called JPD to report a male had just exposed himself to a group of middle school children that got off of his school bus Glacier Hwy at Wire St. The suspect reportedly then got on a city bus and continued toward the Mendenhall Valley.

Officers met the city bus and the person that fit the description of the suspect on Glacier Hwy near Alaway Ave. As officers contacted the suspect, he fled on foot down an embankment and across creeks and a grassy field. Officers caught up to the suspect and took him into custody. He was identified as 20 year old Matthew DOUGLAS- MARTIN.

DOUGLAS-MARTIN was lodged at the Lemon Creek Correctional Center for Disorderly Conduct and Resisting Arrest and held on bail.

All factual allegations contained in this release are based upon preliminary investigation and are subject to change or clarification as the investigation continues. Any charges reported in this release are merely accusations and all persons named in this release are presumed innocent unless and until proven guilty.
