Summary:

On 12/25/2010, at approximately 8:00 am, the Juneau Police Department received a report of a fight taking place between an adult male and adult female at a residence on Lemon Creek Road, in the Lemon Creek area. No injuries were reported.

Upon officer's arrival to the area, they contacted a 43-year old male walking away from the residence. The male stated that he had been occupying a residence with Cheryl DILG, 46-years of age. He said they had earlier gotten into a verbal argument, which continued into the morning. He said that during the argument, DILG had taken out a large kitchen knife and pointed it at his neck, threatening him with it. The male said he was in fear for his life. He said DILG had left the residence after the incident. Several large kitchen knives were taken into evidence.

At approximately 10:00 am, officers contacted DILG, who had returned to the residence. After being interviewed, she was placed under arrest for assault in the third degree, domestic violence (C Felony). She was lodged at Lemon Creek Correctional Center on no bail.

All factual allegations contained in this release are based upon preliminary investigation and are subject to change or clarification as the investigation continues. Any charges reported in this release are merely accusations and all persons named in this release are presumed innocent unless and until proven guilty.
