Summary:

On Wednesday, April 25, 2007, at approximately 3:39 am, the Juneau Police Department received a report from a subject in the downtown area stating that he believed someone had forcibly made entry into his other residence, and was possibly still in it. Officers arrived to the area and spoke with the reporting subject. He stated that the residence in question is next door to the one he and his wife reside in. The residence doubles as his office/storage unit, but also as an apartment.

Responding Officers noted that the front door to the residence, which leads into a common hallway, had been forced open. An interior door to one of the two apartments had also been kicked open.

Officers located a male inside the apartment who was found rummaging through numerous items. He was identified as Clinton KEARNEY, a 35 year old local male. The owner of the building stated that KEARNEY did not have his permission to be in the residence.

KEARNEY was placed under arrest for Burglary in the First Degree (B Felony) and Criminal Mischief in the Fourth Degree (A Misdemeanor). He was lodged at the Lemon Creek Correctional Center.

Any charges reported in this press release are merely accusations and the defendants are presumed innocent unless and until proven guilty.
