Subject: Juneau Burglaries

Summary: During the month of January, Juneau has experienced about a dozen residential burglaries from downtown Juneau to about 19 mile Glacier Hwy. Homes are targeted during the daytime hours and homes that are generally hidden from public view by shrubbery or being away from public view. Most of the burglarized homes have been unlocked.

During investigation of these crimes, officers found that medication, lap top computers, cash and easily carried small electronics are being taken. Witnesses have described a possible suspect as being a dark complected male in his late teens or early twenties, about 5'9" with a thin to moderate build and black hair. When confronted by citizens, the suspect has left the area without a confrontation.

The Juneau Police Dept. reminds you to lock your doors when away and to be alert to suspicious subjects in their neighborhood. The Juneau Police Department is actively pursuing leads in this case and if a person has pertinent information they are encouraged to call the Department at 586-0600.

Any charges reported in this press release are merely accusations and the defendants are presumed innocent unless and until proven guilty.
