Thank you for the opportunity to listen in on this afternoon's (Friday, 24 April) meeting of the Economic Stabilization Task Force. I appreciate your diligence on these crucial matters.

I consider housing and shelter to be one of the most essential of the "essential services", and believe that their accelerated provision should be a key element of our economic recovery, as well as of our recovery from the coronavirus pandemic, since lack of a home or shelter makes social distancing and other health practices vastly more difficult. I would like to know more about the current status of Covid19 protocols for residential construction projects, and what might be done to encourage more local residential construction and to stabilize the employment of workers in the building trades, while assuring the health and safety of these workers.
