I did not listen to your last meeting. In the notes, I see no mention Construction which there is typically a rising demand for this time of year. Local Unions could also help train rapidly. Seafood processing mostly takes place outside of Juneau, I think it is a good idea to ask other localities if they need workers in this sector, and find residents here who want those jobs.

I think 2019-06(AC) needs modifications:

Split the amount you presented into two parts: 75% is a grant, and 25% is a low interest loan to be paid back, in 3-10 years.

Any grant funds not spent by October 1, 2020 must be returned. The grant funds must be spent on wages of employees of the recipient business (excluding any individual with more than 25% ownership of the business or immediate family members) or of anyone physically located in Juneau working for any legally registered entity.

The loan amount may be spent on anything.
