



JPD 2019 Use of Force Rates

- JPD handled 32,605 police response calls in 2019
 - For an average of 89 police contacts per day.
- Of those 32,605 calls: there were 5,022 cases and 1,815 arrests
 - For an average of 4.9 arrests per day
- Force was used by 54 officers against 38 people.
 - Of 1,815 arrests, 38 people constitutes 2.1%
 - 97.9% of arrests needed no reportable force
 - Of 32,605 police contacts, 38 people constitutes 0.12%
 - 99.88% of police contacts had no reportable force



Types of Force Used by JPD in 2019

- 22 - Hands
- 22 - Pepper Spray
- 15 - Taser
- 5 - Baton
- 2 - Firearm
- Reportable Use of Force is any force greater than a firm grip.
- 54 Officers reported using force in 2019.
- 31 Officers reported using force in 2018.
- 66 applications of force were used in 2019 because in several situations an officer used more than one type of force during the incident.

Force by Gender

- 32 males (84.2%)
- 6 females (15.8%)

Force by Race

- 26 white (68.4%)
- 8 Alaska Native (21.0%)
- 4 Asian/Pacific Islander (10.5%)

Force by Gender and Race

- 24 white males (63.1%)
- 7 Alaska Native males (18.4%)
- 1 Asian/Pacific Islander male (2.6%)
- 2 white females (5.3%)
- 1 Alaska Native female (2.6%)
- 3 Asian/Pacific Islander females (7.9%)
