Members , both my companies Alaska Juneau Mining Company and Juneau Trading Company have been forced to close (simply put we never opened our doors) due to 100% cancellation of Alaska cruise ship season and the lack of independent visitors.

Alaska Juneau Mining had one employee for 4th qtr. 2019 and the same for 1<sup>st</sup> Qtr. 2020 . Juneau Trading also had one employee for the 4<sup>th</sup> qtr. 2019 and the same for 1<sup>st</sup> qtr. 2020. We lost the opportunity to hire approx. 50 summer jobs this year. Since we never opened our doors there was no sales tax filing for our seasonal business in 2020. We just don't have the funds to cover all the current debt service (rent, inventory , etc.) for both stores . This grant will provide a much-needed lifeline.
