



Phase-In: Phase IV

Updated February 19th 2021

The Division of Aquatics has worked diligently toward welcoming patrons back in the facility with modifications to prevent the spread of the COVID-19 virus. Operations will move into Phase IV of reopening, information on operational and schedule changes are provided below.

Please note, these changes go into effect on Monday March 1st, 2021

**Augustus Brown Swimming Pool & Dimond Park Aquatic Center will operate in Phase IV.
Please note, lap lanes are no longer restricted to single households.**

Amenities Offered in Phase IV

- Drop-in recreation will continue; recreating on a reservation only basis is no longer in effect.
- Locker rooms will remain open for public use, showers will continue to be available.
- Fitness Decks - masks required when using
- Lap Pools - lap lanes are no longer restricted to single households
- Recreation Pools - spray features resume operation at DPAC

Amenities Offline in Phase IV

- Hot tub and saunas
- Lobby tables and chairs (**no loitering**)
- Instructional programming
- Facility rentals

Facility Guidelines

1. Employees will continue wear face coverings while directly dealing with the public, and when 6 ft. of distance cannot be maintained among another staff member.
2. Per **CBJ Emergency Ordinance No. 2020-05** members of the public are still required to wear face coverings in our common spaces (fitness deck, lobby, front desk, and locker rooms/restrooms). Face coverings will be provided.
3. Social distancing of at least six feet recommended between individuals and household groups when in the common spaces, as well as the natatorium.
 - i. Plastic “sneeze guards” are installed at the front desk, and in between each lane at DPAC to allow for an extra degree of separation where distancing is not possible.
 - ii. Floor stanchions and markings are installed to direct flow of traffic when entering and exiting aquatic facilities.

Hygiene & Cleaning Measures

1. Aquatics staff will wash their hands frequently and pool patrons are encouraged to do the same.
2. Hand sanitizer will be available upon arrival.
3. The fitness deck, locker & family changing rooms will be wiped down at the top of every hour.
4. The entire facility will be closed to the public to be thoroughly cleaned and disinfected prior to open, during the mid-day closure, and at close to provide a safe and sanitized facility.
5. No member of the public displaying symptoms of COVID-19 may be present in public facilities.

Staffing

1. No employee displaying symptoms of COVID-19 are permitted to work.
2. Employees displaying COVID-19 symptoms and/or employee who have tested positive for COVID-19 will follow CDC guidance for discontinuation of isolation for persons with COVID-19 regarding returning to work: <https://www.cdc.gov/coronavirus/2019-ncov/hcp/disposition-in-home-patients.html>
