    - iv. What about the Director for the Alaska Human Rights Commission?
    - v. Angel will reach out and hopefully find someone to speak on Alaska related Black History on Feb. 23.
    - vi. Britt will reach out for someone to speak on March 9, the day after International Women's Day
    - vii. Ibn has been tasked to reach out and suggest March 23 for the Director of the Alaska Human Rights Commission.
