








JPL provides: paper template


Step 1: Fold sheet of paper in half, short end to short end, words on outside of paper. Press and smooth fold.




Step 2: Fold in half again, parallel to first fold. Press and smooth fold.



Step 3: Unfold





Step 4: Fold sheet of paper in half in other direction, long edge to long edge. Press and smooth fold.




Step 5: Unfold

Step 6: Refold on original fold – cut on center fold line, from center to 1st fold.



Step 7: Unfold

Step 8: Refold long sides together




Step 9: Pinch sides together to form an open diamond shape. (similar motion to ASL sign for "together")





Step 10: Keep pinching to form 3 ½ x 7" rectangle




Step 11: Front will display “Alaska flag design...” on left.



Step 12: Fold in half one more time, with “My Alaska Flag Song Book” for cover. Press and smooth firmly on all edges.



Step 13: Color your book and sing our song!
