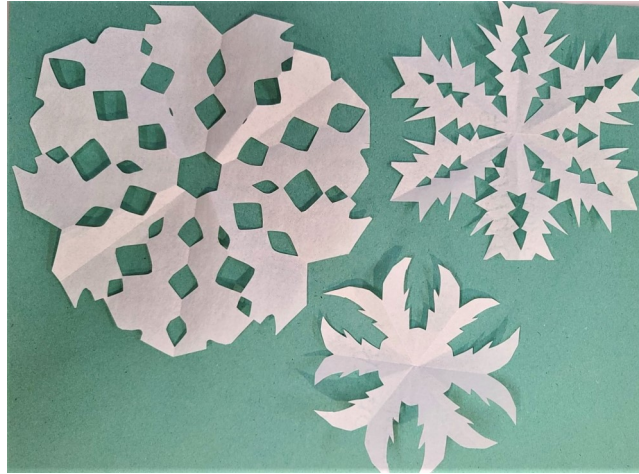




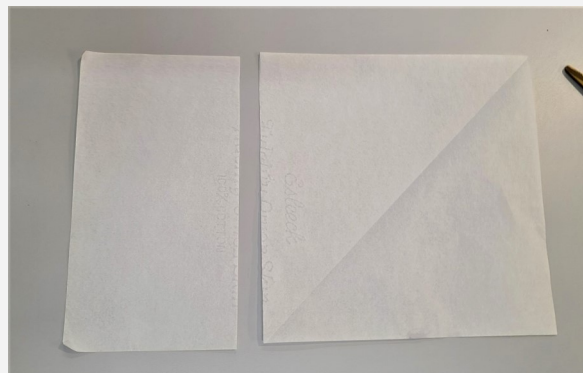
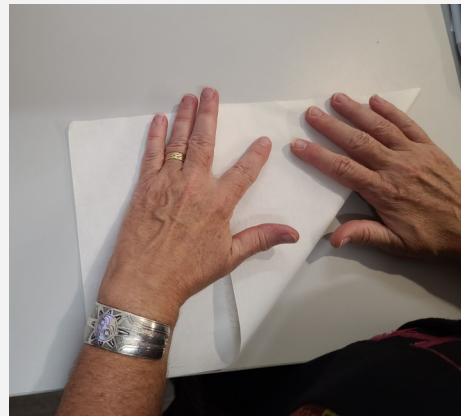
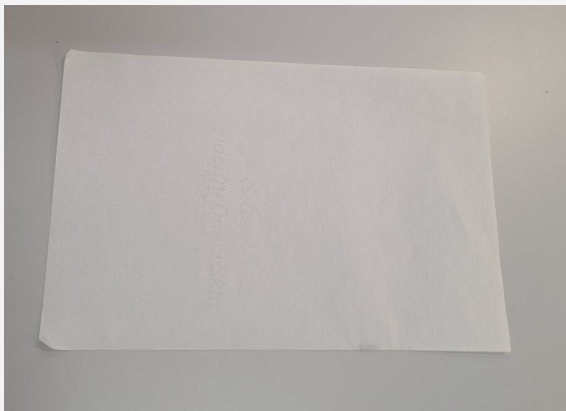
Snowflakes Craft



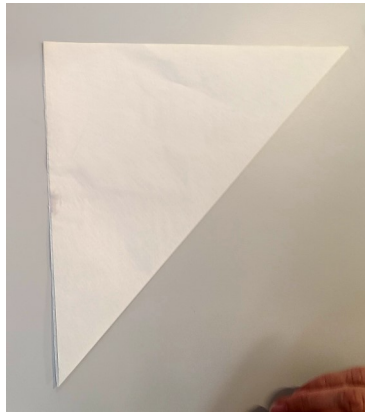
Supplies Available for pick up December 8 or print your own using templates provided.

JPL provides: paper, snowflake templates. You provide scissors, creativity.

Step 1: Start with a square piece of paper...(If your paper is not square, no problem. Fold your paper on the diagonal, and cut off the extra section.)



Step 2: Fold in Half Diagonally. (You may have already done this to make a square)



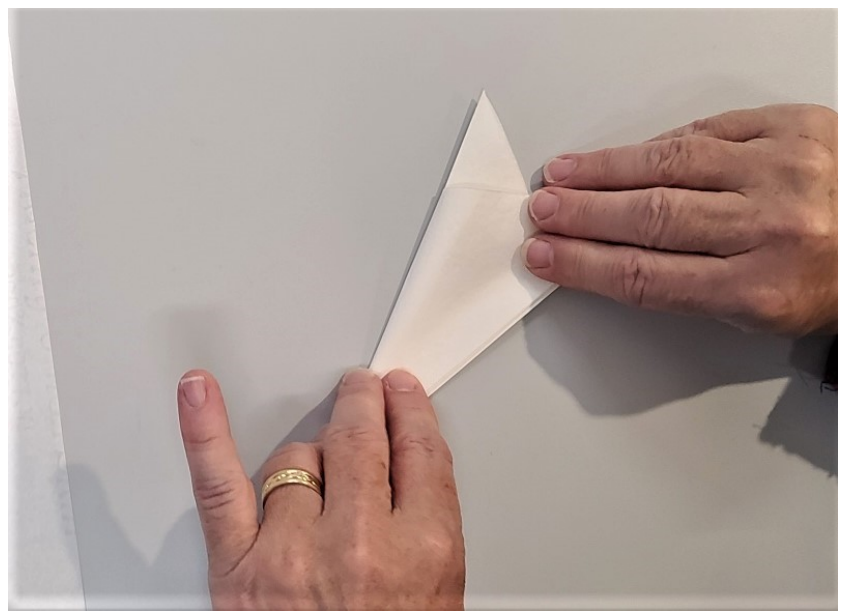
Step 3: Fold in Half Again. ...



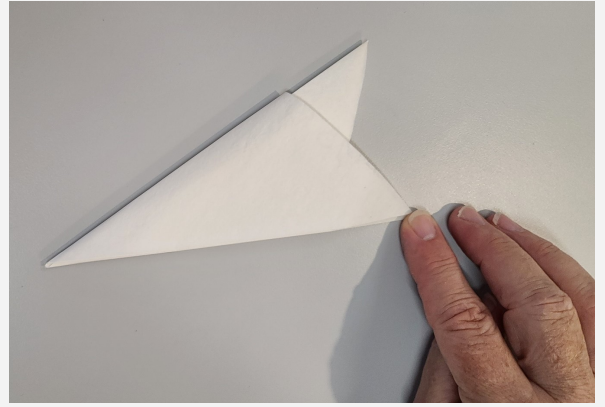
Step 4: Fold one section to divide the shape into thirds.
(because Snowflakes are 6 sided) ...
this is tricky.



Step 5: Fold Again. ... match the edges as close as you can. You may need to adjust the folds a bit.



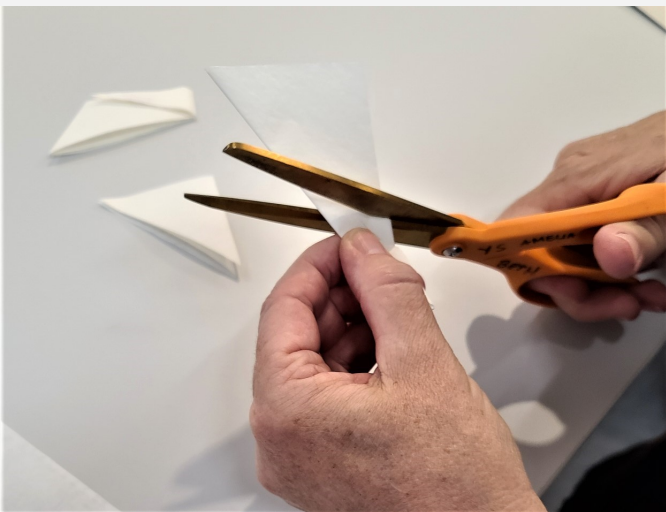
The tri-fold will look something like this ...



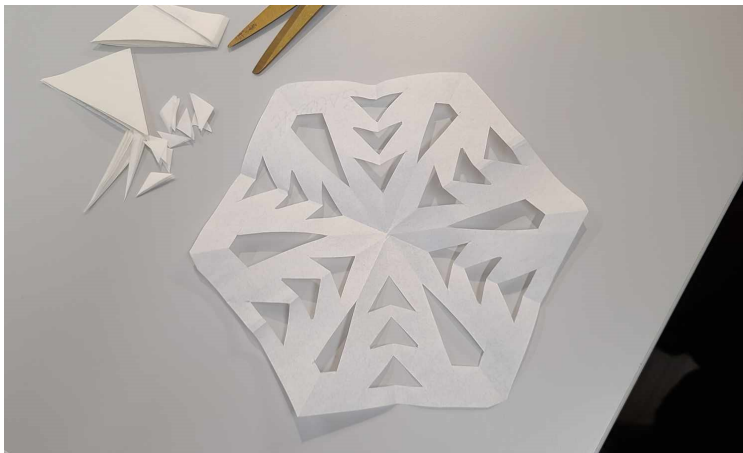
Step 6: Cut the "top" (unmatched edges) off at an Angle...



Step 7: Shape It! Cut shapes from each edge – Careful! Don't cut all the way through!



Step 8: Unfold to Reveal!
