The Alaska Department of Environmental Conservation (DEC) has completed its review of your Notice of Intent (NOI) requesting coverage for the Alaska Airlines Juneau Station under the 2020 Multi-Sector General Permit for Storm Water Discharges Associated with Industrial Activities (MSGP). DEC has determined that storm water discharges are appropriately covered by the MSGP, **Sector S - Air Transportation Facilities** and is hereby issuing wastewater discharge authorization **AKR06AC07**. Discharges from the facility are authorized under the MSGP effective as of the date of this letter and expires March 31, 2025. Attached is your authorization to discharge.

The permittee is reminded by February 15th of the year following the reporting year, the permittee is required to submit the Annual Report as provided in Appendix F.
