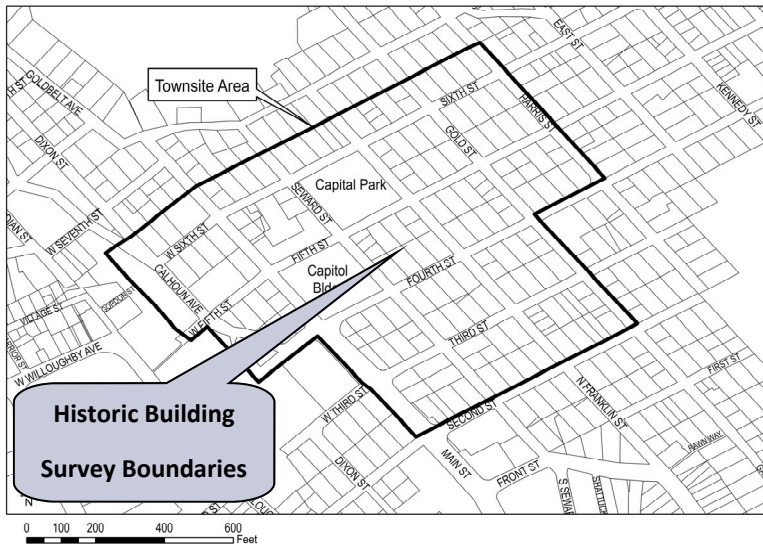


# Public Meeting for Juneau Townsite Property Owners—April 26th at 6:00pm

The CBJ Community Development Department will begin **conducting Phase 2 of a Historic Building Survey and Inventory in the Juneau Townsite in April 2023**. NorthWind Architects, along with a local historian and researcher, will be assisting with the project. ## PROJECT DETAILS:

- ◆ The project is being funded through a grant from the State of Alaska Office of History and Archaeology.
- ◆ The boundaries of the survey and inventory (Phases 1 & 2) are 2nd Street to the south, 6th Street to the north, Harris Street to the east and Calhoun Avenue to the west.
- ◆ Only exterior architectural and historical data will be collected.
- ◆ All information gathered during the project will be publicly available through the CBJ webpage.

**This is an in-person only meeting being held at McPhetres Hall, which is located on the lower level of Church of the Holy Trinity (415 Fourth Street). The entrance to the hall is on Gold Street.**
