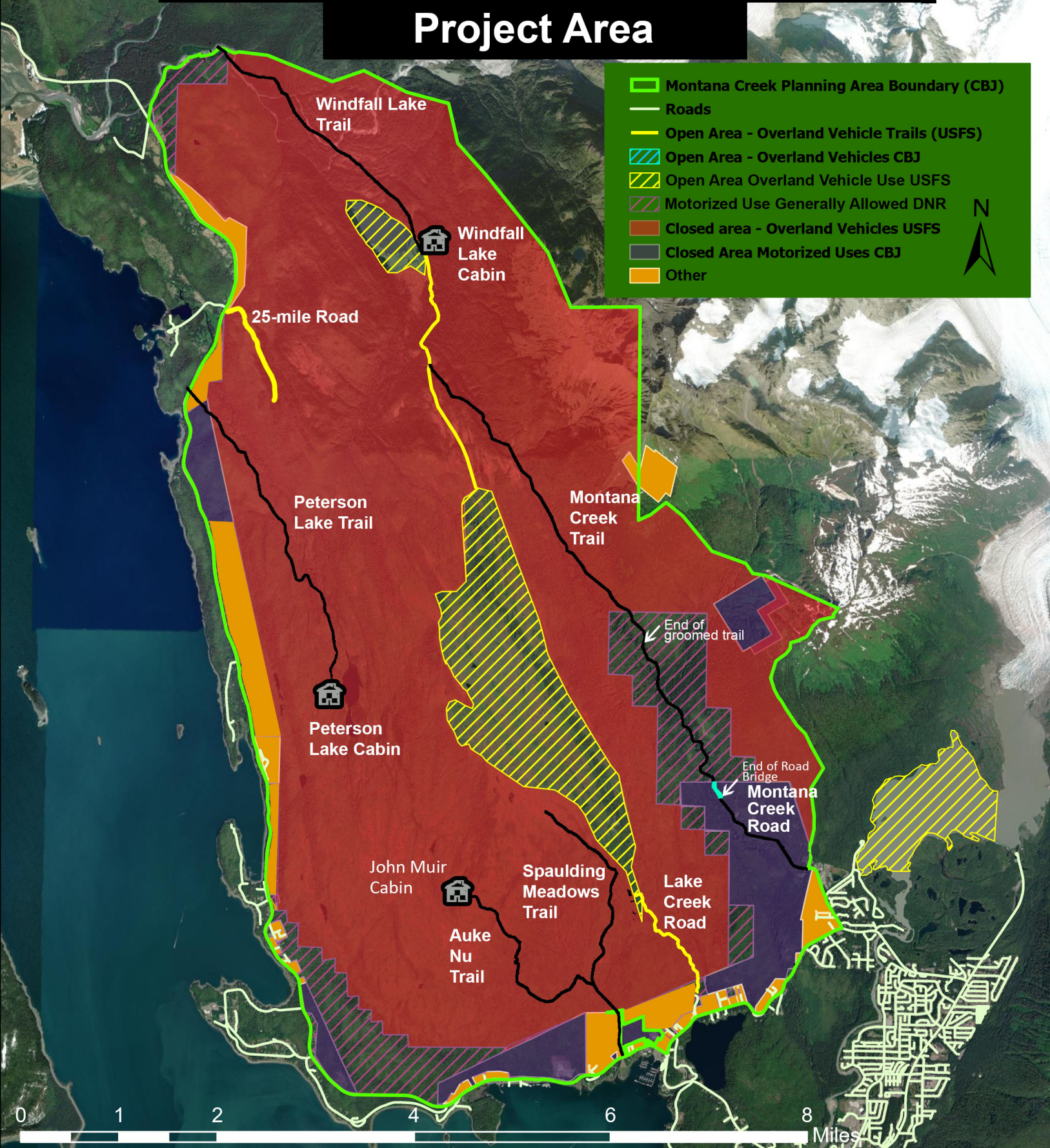


Overland Vehicle Use in Montana Creek Project Area

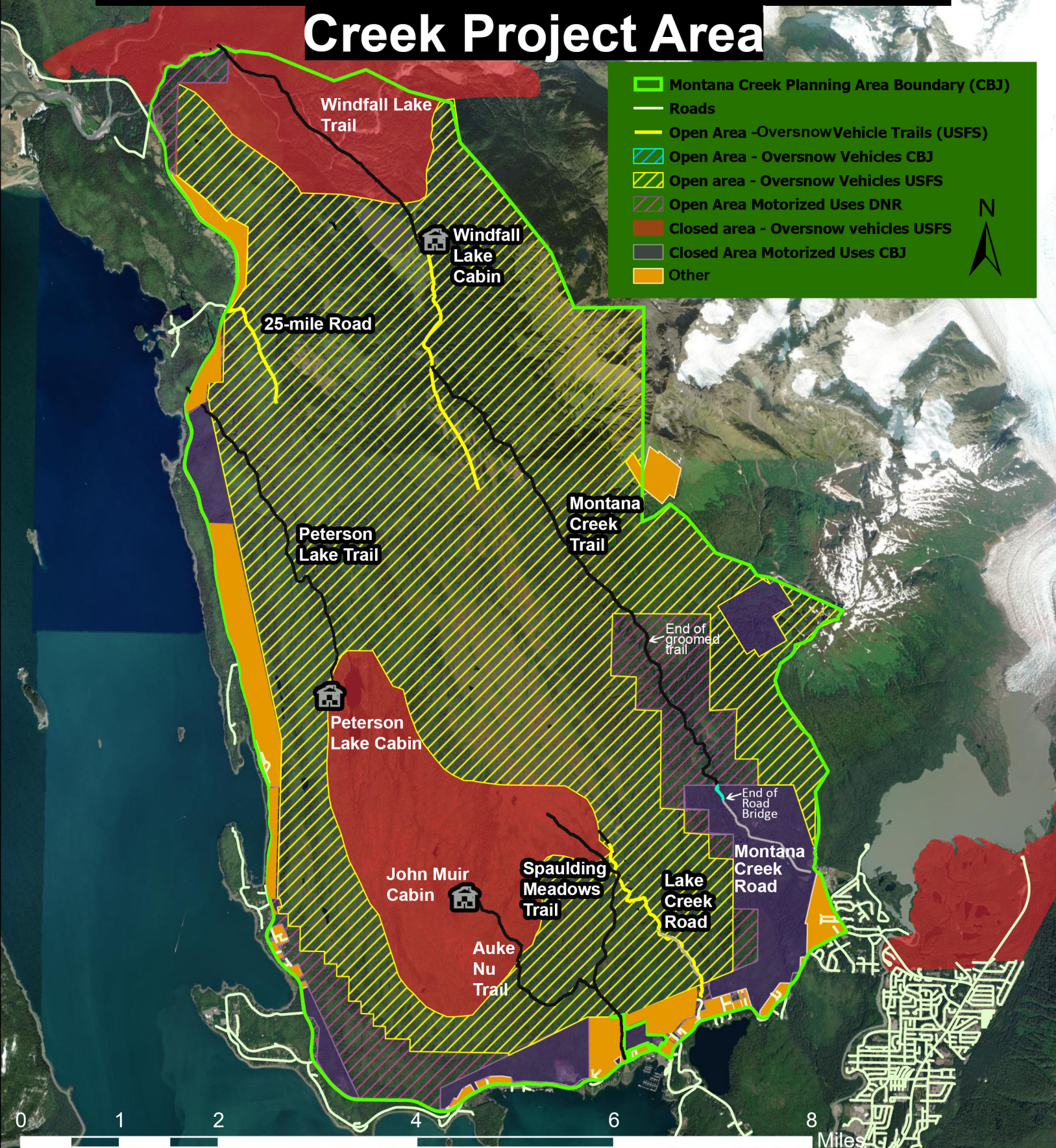


Description of Use by Land Manager:

USFS - Open and closed areas are for "overland vehicles" defined as wheeled vehicles such as ATVs or dirtbikes with 50" or less vehicle width. Open areas are seasonal, 12/15-4/15 with a minimum of 12" of snow present. 25-Mile Road is open year round regardless of snow depth. Oversnow vehicles use (tracked machines) is not designated on this map. **DNR** - Motorized Use must not exceed conditions in DNR's Generally Allowed Use regulations per 11AAC 96.020. The operation of wheeled or tracked vehicles in a specified anadromous waterbody requires a fish habitat permit under AS 16.05.871. **CBJ** - Motorized use is prohibited on parkland and allowed in Right of Way.

Oversnow Vehicle Use in Montana

Description of Use by Land Manager:

USFS - Map depicts open and closed areas for "oversnow vehicles" defined as tracked vehicles such as snow machines and snow bikes. Use is allowed only with a minimum of 12" of snow present as measured at the end of the hardened Lake Creek Trail. 25-mile Road is open year round regardless of snow depths.

DNR - Motorized Use must not exceed conditions in DNR's Generally Allowed Use regulations per 11AAC 96.020. The operation of wheeled or tracked vehicles in a specified anadromous waterbody requires a fish habitat permit under AS 16.05.871.

CBJ - Motorized use is prohibited on parkland and allowed in Right of Way.
