RE: Alaska Department of Transportation FY2024 Human Services Transportation Services Grant

The Juneau Coordinated Transportation Coalition (JCTC) is a coalition of community partners that work together to make the most of available resources to improve the effectiveness and efficiency of transportation in Juneau, Alaska.

JCTC efforts and priorities are summarized in the adopted <u>2020 Juneau Coordinated Human Services</u> <u>Transportation Plan.</u>

Each year the local community is eligible to put forward a grant proposal for the <u>Alaska Department of</u> <u>Transportation Human Services Transportation Service Grant</u>. In FY 2023, SAIL was the selected local applicant and received funds for its Replacement ADA Taxi program.

## FY2024 Human Services Transportation Services Grant

This year one local application was received for the JCTC to consider. SAIL requests capital for an expansion ADA Taxi for its ADA Taxi program. In FY23, SAIL served ~1000+ seniors & people with disabilities, over 300 who reside in Juneau. Approximately 50% of SAIL consumers are beneficiaries of the Alaska Mental Health Trust Authority. The request is for \$86,250.

JCTC is asked to review the SAIL application and make a recommendation to the CBJ Public Works and Facilities Committee. The recommendation of a prioritized request will be included as an addendum to the 2020 Juneau Coordinated Human Services Transportation Plan.
