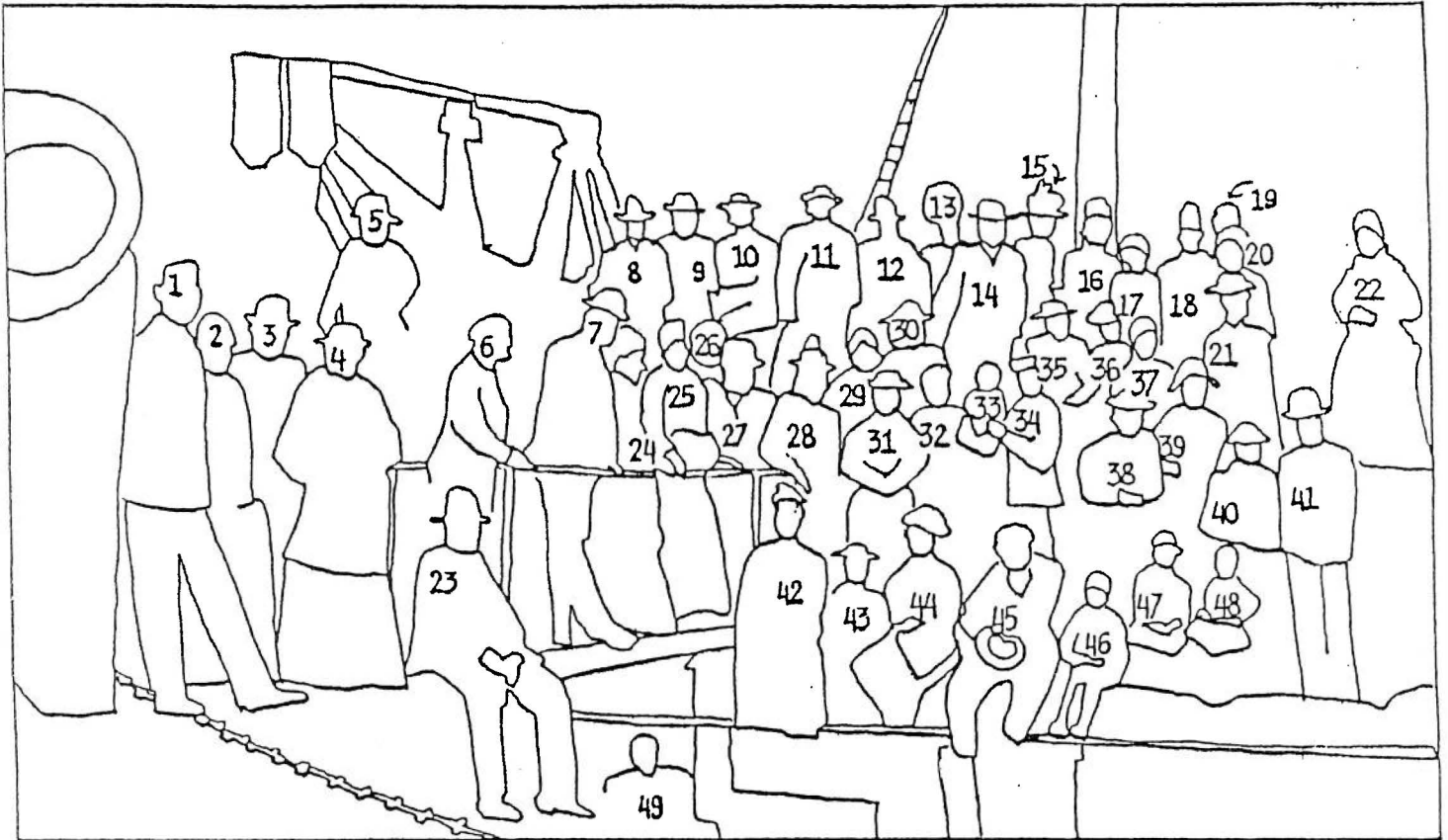


## Ancon
