Reservation Policies

- Reservations of the Dimond Park Aquatic Center Event Rooms must be completed online at least three (3) days prior to the request date and time.
- Payment & rental agreement form are due immediately upon reservation.
- Credit or refunds will only be given for facility rentals if notification is received at least two (2) days prior to the facility rental. There is a \$10.00 service charge for each cancelled hour.
- Three (3) day rescheduling notice is required.

Rental Policies

- All users must abide by all pool rules and policies. Rules and policies are posted at the Dimond Park Aquatic Center.
- Persons who appear to be under the influence of alcohol or other substances are not permitted in the facility. In accordance with CBJ ordinance 20.25.080 (d) alcoholic beverages are strictly prohibited.
- Verbal abuse or physical violence will not be tolerated. Persons engaging in abusive activity will be removed from the facility immediately and possibly banned from both Aquatic facilities.
- For children 8 years and younger, there must be a ratio of one (1) Adult (18+) per three (3) children. Children who are 8 years and younger who cannot pass a swim test must remain within arm's reach of an Adult while on the pool deck and in the water.
- All users must leave the facility in a condition considered satisfactory to pool staff. Any group or user actions resulting in damages or destruction of City property will be held responsible for the cost of repair or replacement. Extra cleaning costs will be billed to the renter.
- Application of materials to the wall, floors, doors, or windows will not be allowed without permission from the Pool Supervisor.
- All rentals must start and end as scheduled. A group that arrives late will not have time added to compensate.
- Misuse of the facility or failure to conform to these policies will be sufficient reason for denying future facility rentals.
- This rental is for event room time only - it does not close the remainder of the facility to the public.
