STAY INFORMED

Stay up to date with the types of emergencies most likely to affect the Juneau area-fires, floods, landslides, earthquakes, etc.

Know the emergency plans already in place. Be familiar with evacuation routes and shelters

The likelihood of surviving an emergency increases with preparation. Plan for at least 3-7 days of displacement.



BE PREPARED

Build Your Pet's "SAFE-SAK"

- **FOOD:** At least 3 days of your pet's food (small cans if canned). Include can opener.
- **WATER:** 3 days of water + a small bowl.
- **MEDICINE:** Extra supply of regular meds.
- **RECORDS:** Vet records, microchip #, photo, contacts.
- **COLLAR & TAGS:** Rabies, ID tag, CBJ dog license. Include backup collars & leashes.
- **MICROCHIP:** Microchipping helps reunite lost pets. JAR can register your pet locally and nationally.
- **PET CARRIER:** Reduces stress and ensures safety. Store your "SAFE-SAK" inside if space allows.
- **SANITATION:** Poo bags, wipes, towels, litter, litter pan.
- **PHOTOS:** Of each pet and you together for ID purposes.
- **FAMILIAR ITEMS:** Favorite toy, blanket to reduce stress.
Store items in a waterproof backpack, bucket or bin.

PREPARE IN ADVANCE

- ☀ Assemble an evacuation kit for yourself and your pets.
- ☀ Make sure your pet is licensed and microchipped with Juneau Animal Rescue (JAR)
