APPLICATION REQUIREMENTS

Volunteer applicants must provide the following:

- Volunteer Application Form
- Two Letters of Reference
- Criminal Background Check
 - This can be obtained through the Department of Public Safety, Criminal Records and Identification (R&I) Bureau located in the Dimond Courthouse at:
123 4th Street, Juneau, AK 99801
- Driving Record
 - Visit online.dmv.alaska.gov/onlinedrivingrecords to obtain this online or for details on in-person options
 - If you have lived in Alaska for less than 2 years, you must also provide a driving record from your previous state
- Information Release Form
- Color Copy of Driver's License



All above requirements must be completed and submitted together for the application to be considered.

APPLICATION PROCESS

If you pass the initial screening, you will be contacted to come in for an interview. This interview will be similar to an informal job interview. If the selection committee approves your interview, you will be asked to fill out the second half of the application.

Once that portion of the application is processed, you will be assigned a mentor and given a Volunteer Manual to guide you through next steps.
